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



#### Beautiful China(12)

The idea of constructing “Beautiful China” was first proposed in the report of the 18<sup>th</sup> CPC National Congress, 2012. But serious pollution problems such as haze and water pollution have become barriers to the sustainable development of China.

To realize the goal of “Beautiful China”, comprehensive laws and regulations, efficient execution, and public awareness and engagement are necessary.

#### Bruno Briseghella: Bridge China and Italy(22)

Professor Briseghella owns an international fame in the field of bridge designing. Currently, he works at Fuzhou University. “Fuzhou is similar to my hometown—Venice, so it gives me a feeling of home,” Briseghella said. Like Marco Polo, the pioneering communicator between Asia and Europe, Briseghella has contributed a lot to strengthening communication between China and Italy.

#### Wang Guangfa: Dedicated to Talent Cultivation(30)

Wang Guangfa is the president of Beijing Fazheng Group. He established Beijing Royal School in 2003 and introduced a chain of western curricula which aimed to cultivate students with international vision. “China is in need of talent, especially those for industrial transition, while current public education is not enough for the task. As an entrepreneur, I have to take this social responsibility,” Wang Guangfa said.

### IN VIEW

#### Zhang Jianguo: China Needs More Top Foreign Talent(44)

Since 1949 when the People’s Republic of China was founded, thousands of millions of foreign talent came to China and did great contributions to the construction and modernization of China. In recent years, China has been undergoing a rapid economic development which becomes another factor attracting foreign talent. “However, China is still not strong enough in the exploitation of human resources. We have a lot to do to attract foreign talent,” said Zhang Jianguo, administrator of State Administration of Foreign Experts Affairs.
