Conference on International Exchange of Professionals (6)

On April 15, the 15th Conference on International Exchange of Professionals (CIEP) will open in Shenzhen. The CIEP provides a key platform for connecting China with the rest of the world in terms of talent, wisdom, technology, projects, and management. George Smoot, the 2005 Nobel Laureate for Physics will tell why he chose to invest in a 3D company in Beijing, and Danny Alexander, vice president of Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank, will share ideas about what kind of chances the Road and Belt Initiatives will bring to countries at the Global Intelligence Forum. About 80 projects from 8 countries will compete in the final round at the First China (Shenzhen) Innovation & Entrepreneurship International Competition. The conference will also have an international education exhibition, Expo of Asia-Pacific Human Resource Development and Service, and several job fairs, etc.

J. Fraser Stoddart in Tianjin University (26)

In 2014 July, Professor Stoddart began work in Tianjin University two months each year at the School of Pharmaceutical Science and Technology, and one year later, 3 young scientists on his team joined the university as well. The school is a pilot for an initiative to promote university internationalization. Professor Stoddart thought it advantageous to do research in the school, because of its academic freedom. Last year he shared the Nobel Prize for Chemistry with two other scientists. He said receiving the award was a surprise. He met Premier Li Keqiang before the 2017 Spring Festival, and discussed foreign talent with the Premier.

Foreign Experts Offer Insights on Government Work Report (58)

On January 12, a total of 11 foreign experts from seven countries presented their Ideas regarding the 2017 Government Work Report of China, 2 months before Premier Li Keqiang presented the report at the 5th session of the 13th NPC (National People's Congress) in Beijing. This is the third time for the Government Work Report's drafting group to take suggestions from foreign experts. One suggestion, regarding geriatric nursing, from a Canadian health professional, was that paying more attention to prevention is highly beneficial.
