#### Stories of the Belt and Road (14)

Since 2013, many cooperative projects that were built under the Belt and Road Initiative, such as railways,expressways, and oil pipelines, have been of great benefit to many countries. In this issue, you will read several stories which happened along the Belt and Road: In Indonesia, an engineer worked together with his Chinese counterparts to provide communication service for APEC; in Thailand, a farmer sold her rice to those in China; a famous science fiction piece by Chinese writer Liu Cixin, *The Three Body Problem*, has been translated and published in Turkey, Hungary, and Poland. Zhang Wei from Shanghai Media Group recalled how he participated shooting of a documentary about the Maritime Silk Road: in Pakistan, about one hundred policemen were in charge of security during the whole shooting for over a month; in Southeast Asia, Zhang Wei survived having dengue after timely delivery and treatment from local people and officers of the embassy.

#### Roger Kornberg's New Career in Shenzhen (28)

May 2017, Shenzhen Shiyan Lake International Academician Village, an incubator programme, was opened. Roger Kornberg, the 2006 Nobel Laureate for Chemistry from Stanford University, is the chief scientist of the village. He plans to have mass production of a medicine for hepatitis C at the incubator. He mentions that medicine for hepatitis C is very expensive, and he hopes to decrease its cost in Shenzhen so that Chinese patients could afford it. This is his first goal for the village. In the future, he plans to have mass production of medicines for bird flu and others. Although he, himself, tries so much to transform research into application, he stresses the importance of investment in fundamental research.

#### Al: Is Future in Our Hands? (50)

Yuval Noah Harari, the author of the international bestseller *Sapiens: A Brief History of Humankind*, gave a speech in China on July 6th. Yuval Noah Harari is an Israeli historian and a tenured professor in the Department of History at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and his new book, *Homo Deus: A Brief History of Tomorrow*,was published its Chinese edition in January 2017.In his speech, he pointed that Artificial Intelligence(AI) will know us better than ourselves, and we will depend on AI more and more while making decisions. AI may even replace more and more humans, such as those who are drivers, translators,or even doctors.Due to this,Yuval Noah Harari worried that many people will become useless. But unlike the stories in some science films, there is not any evidence indicating that AI has emotion,consciousness, or mentality.Yuval Noah Harari stressed that even though AI's intelligence is experiencing rapid improvement, its consciousness is zero.
